📢 IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL NATED REPORT 191 ENGINEERING STUDIES STUDENTS!

The Registration Unit is testing a new Auto Application system for all returning students in an attempt to streamline the application and registration process once results are released by DHET.

✅ What this means for you:

If you were registered, and wrote external (DHET) examinations, in T2 of 2025, then you are a part of the testing of the Auto Application system.

If you were registered in T2 of 2025 for 3 of 4 subjects on one N-level OR 4 of 4 subjects on one N-level:

Example:

3 of 4 subjects on one N-level: (Electrical Engineering N4)	4 of 4 subjects on one N-level: (Electrical Engineering N5)
1. Mathematics N4	1. Mathematics N5
2. Engineering Science N4	2. Power Machines N5
3. Electrotechnics N4	3. Electrotechnics N5
	4. Industrial Electronics N5

- The system will determine if you qualify to continue to the next level – this setup is done in accordance with NSFAS guidelines: **you must have passed at least 3 of the 4 subjects on one level for R191 in order to progress to the next level.**
- If you qualify to progress to the next level (i.e. you have passed **3 of 4 or 4 of 4 subjects** in T2 of 2025 on one N-level), the system will then automatically create an application for you on the next N-level and also update your status to **ADMITTED NEXT LEVEL** and you will be able to continue with your registration.
- If you have failed more than two (2) subjects on an N-level in T2 of 2025, then the system will automatically create an application on the same N-level – your status will be changed to **NOT PROMOTED – RE-APPLICATION.**
- If you are Not Promoted, you will need to wait for space to become available before you can continue with registration.
- **UNFORTUNATELY**, no application on the lower N-level will be automatically created for you if you have failed 1 of the 4 subjects enrolled – this is still a manual process, so you will need to apply for that 1 failed subject!
- ✅ Factors that will determine admission for repeaters:
 - Number of subjects to be repeated.
 - Availability of space – there is limited space available for repeating of N4 subjects.
- ✅ What is the way forward?
 - You will still need to apply for studies on your current level for each application period.
